The SFA Health Center works in association with the SFA Counseling Center to provide medical treatment of students with psychological problems including anxiety/depression, bipolar and panic disorders. We also provide medications for eating disorders when indicated. We regularly provide screening and treatment for sexually transmitted diseases, including syphilis, gonorrhea, Chlamydia infections, herpes infections, genital warts, and trichomonas infections. We do not regularly screen for HIV infection, since this is available via Health Horizons in town.

We also carry on an active program for the treatment of attention deficit disorder, which if not treated, is associated with an increased incidence of drug abuse.

Although we do counsel students regarding the detrimental effects of excessive alcohol consumption, we in general see few of these students.
